## Today's Program...

Dale Leslie introduced sportscaster and author Jim Brandstatter. Fall weekends are busy for Jim. Jim also talked about his old coach Bo Schembechler who instilled in him the drive to do his best every time, regardless of what he is doing. Jim said he coaches himself to have a positive attitude and to do the best broadcast he can, regardless of how well or how poorly a team is playing. He said when things aren't going well he tries to broadcast a sense of hope. He also said he hated hearing the boos at Michigan Stadium on Saturday. He said the players are young kids who are working hard and trying to do what the coaches want them to do. Jim doesn't know who will replace Frank Beckman when he retires at the end of the season. He doubts that an announcement will be made before the end of the season. He also said he will let Robbie know we missed her!
