Today's Program.....


Dale Leslie introduced our speaker Rick Jones, Michigan State Senator (Republican, District 24) representing the counties of Eaton, Barry, and Allegan. After 33 years in law enforcement, culminating in being elected Sheriff of Eaton County in 2000, Jones entered politics as a state representative. After being elected in 2010, he is now in his first term as senator. He is a member of 4 committees and is chairman of the prestigious and very busy judiciary committee. Rick is committed to protecting seniors and is fighting to maintain the absence of state taxes on pensions and homesteads. He also supports cracking down on domestic violence offenders and protecting citizens from violent criminals, areas where his earlier experience in law enforcement



has been valuable. Getting tough on dog fighting (a "blood sport") is another area of focus. Senator Jones has also introduced legislation aimed at improving the use of tax revenues for education. When asked about the new medical marijuana law, he stated that this issue is in his view a "terrible mess", and for the most part the law is simply a mechanism for the vast majority of users to simply get away with smoking pot. 
