Today's Program....




Kathy Barden Perlberg introduced our speaker, UM Marching Band Director Dr. John Pasquale. On June 1 Dr. Pasquale officially replaced Scott Boerma, who had resigned from the position in January to become director of bands at Western Michigan University. He received his BS degree at Texas Christian University and went on to obtain a doctorate in musical arts at the University of Oklahoma. He had served as assistant director of bands at the UM for the previous 5 years. John is "thrilled" to be working with what he believes is the

"best band in the country" and a group consisting of "genius level" students. In addition to being Director of Bands, he holds a teaching position in the School of Music and has given lectures all over the world. Interestingly, he noted that only 7 of the 400 current marching band members are music students. The UM Band is the only such program in the country that has its own endowment, which he believes will soon be large enough to financially support most aspects of band activities including salaries and even student scholarships ("not first year students -- they have to earn it"). Planning for a football season begins in January and takes about 6 months to put together 8 shows. John is excited about the coming season, which he believes will be "incredible". He is proud to have recently brought on board the first female band staff-person in UM history.


