## Today's Program.....

**Linda Berg** of the Ann Arbor Youth Chorale and soloist **Magdalen Fossum** who sang and played the ukulele. The program was Introduced by **Dan Burroughs**.

Linda Berg taught elementary vocal music in the Ann Arbor School System for 22 years. She started by thanking the club for our support of the AA Youth Chorale since 2007. Our support is used for scholarships that help students who need financial assistance to participate with the choral group. The AA Youth Chorale was founded in 1987 by Dr. Richard Ingram of Huron High School. The primary purpose of the group was to give children training in music with an emphasis on performance and the development of social skills. Children are placed at various levels ranging from the Beginning Choir to the Concert Choir. Choir groups have performed around the US and internationally including Vienna and Prague. They have performed with the Ann Arbor Symphony and Detroit Symphony Orchestras, as well as many other local groups. They sing for all occasions, including special events at Mott's Children's Hospital. Magdalen Fossum is twelve years old and has been performing since she was seven. She was named the "Stage Performer of the Year" by the Ark in 2010. Magdalen performed three songs with a variety of styles.

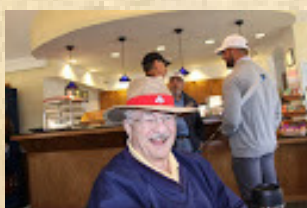
