

TODAY'S PROGRAM... Black History Month



Dr. Larry Lee Rowley

Carter G. Woodson and the Idea of Black History



Larry L. Rowley, Ph.D. LBMC Associates

Today's speaker was Dr. Larry Lee Rowley speaking about the importance of Black History Month. Doctor Rowley was formerly on the faculty of the U-M and is a fraternity brother of President William. The objectives of Black History Month are to preserve the past, protect the present, and prepare for the future. Black History Month was originated in 1926 by Carter G. Woodson, a noted African American historian, scholar, educator, and publisher. Dr. Woodson was the son of slaves and the second black to receive a doctorate from Harvard. February was chosen to coincide with Frederick Douglas' and Abraham Lincoln's birthdays.

Dr. Rowley said that our heritage and diversity are strengths of our country, but we are facing both internal and external challenges. Dr. Rowley recommended two books for those interested in learning more about the topic. They are *What is African-American History?* by Pero Gaglo Dagbovie and *The Mis-Education of the Negro* by Carter G. Woodson. Dr. Rowley then achieved a lifetime objective when he received a genuine Kiwanis coffee mug.
