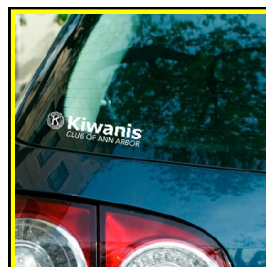

2019 NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION...

Learn to use Signup Genius to schedule yourself for Thrift Sale Tasks. It's easy, here's how to do it:

Easy Access to Signup Genius and Signing up for Thrift Sale Tasks in 8 easy steps.

1. Log on to the Club web site with your friendly browser: a2kiwanis.org
2. In the bottom line of the blue banner at the top of the website, double click on "SignUps" (or you can double click on "Sign Ups" where it appears as the next to last item on the left side of the page).
3. This will bring up a new view below the blue top banner with a SignUps header at the top and an orange SignnUp Genius Icon in the middle of the page.
4. Double click the Icon to bring up a screen showing Six Kiwanis SignUp areas
 - a. If you are part of the Monday-Saturday Sorting Group (primary and departmental sorting, pricing, testing/repairing furniture, electronics, appliances or lights, stocking shelves) click on Tasks, Thrift Sale (M,T,W,Th,F&S) to bring up the actual SignUp page for this group.
 - b. If you are part of the Friday-Saturday Thrift Sale Group (cashiers, sales, wrappers, greeters, and dockers or combinations of these positions) click on Tasks, Thrift Sale (F &S to bring up the actual SignUp page for this group.
5. You will see the respective tasks for workers in each group.....scroll down to see the list of tasks for the current signup period. To signup for a task on a given date, click on the Sign Up area and a checkmark will appear in the area; repeat this for all the dates you can work during the period (currently from July 1- Sept 30).
6. After you have entered the task for all the dates you want, click Submit and Sign Up at the bottom of the page.
7. The next page will show you what you have signed up for and will ask for your first and last name, your email address and a phone number (Mobile, Home or Work).
8. Final step: Click on Sign Up Now to save your choices. You will receive a reminder email two days prior to your selected work dates. If conflicts arise, you can go back in the system in the manner described above to alter dates and tasks. Bob Gray will use Signup Genius schedule data complete the Schedule Spreadsheets sent out each week.

FROM VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR SONIA PETERSON...
