**Who is the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor?**

- We are Members, Volunteers, and Staff who help children, youth, families, & our community.
- February 2020, the Kiwanis Club and Foundation of Ann Arbor had 135 members, 150 volunteers, and 6 full-time and 9 part-time staff. In 2018 we provided over 38,000 volunteer hours. Our Club was chartered in 1921. Our Thrift Sale first opened in 1927, our Foundation in 1965.

**Since 1921 over \$7,500,000.**

In 2019, Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation distributed over \$644,000.

- \$96,500 in Kiwanis Vouchers for Free Household Goods to 445 Individuals and Families.
- \$77,700 in direct gifts of Free Furniture and Supplies to Non-Profit Organizations.
- \$75,000 in Scholarships: 20 - \$3,500 "Finish Line Scholarships" and a \$2,000 emergency fund to Washtenaw Comm College students, & \$500 each to six MS students for music camps.
- \$136,800 Warm The Children as its Official Sponsor. Giving 1,520 families new winter clothing.
- \$19,000 Salvation Army Annual Bell Ringing campaign.
- \$40,000 in Financial and Material Support for Residential Summer Camperships for Children.
- \$199,000 to support Local Children and Family Agencies and Services through our annual Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation Grant Process. (See list on other side.)

**Other Services and Gifts from Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Members, in addition to our Kiwanis Thrift Sale, include:**

- Long Standing and On-Going Donations of Volunteer Time and Financial Support to:
  - Meals on Wheels: over 4,300 meals delivered last year.
  - C. S. Mott Children's Hospital's Child & Family Life Services Program.
  - Packaged over 10,000 Meals for the Kids Coalition Against Hunger Program.
  - Kiwanis Service Leadership and Youth Programs. Sponsored Red Cross Blood Drives
- Continued planning for our new Kiwanis Environmental Education Preserve (KEEP).
- \$92,000 provided by members over the last 9 years to the Haiti Nursing Foundation.
- \$107,000 provided by members over 5 years in a shared effort with UNICEF and our Kiwanis International to Eliminate Maternal Neonatal Tetanus (MNT) across the world.
- \$104,000 provided by members in the 1990's for the Kiwanis and UNICEF campaign to end Iodine Deficiency Disorders (IDD) across the world.
