## Community Impact Report

### Who is the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor?

- We are Members, Volunteers, and Staff who help children, youth, families, & our community.
- October 2021, the Kiwanis Club and Foundation of Ann Arbor had 133 members, 117 volunteers, and 5 full-time and 6 part-time staff. In FY2021 we provided over 18,852 volunteer hours. Our Club was chartered in 1921 and our Foundation in 1965. Our Thrift Sale opened in 1927.

**KIWANIS THRIFT SALE** is open **FRIDAYS** and **SATURDAYS** 9am to 1pm, except some holidays. **DONATIONS** on Saturdays Only 9am to noon, weather permitting. Located at 100 N. Staebler Rd. Suite C, just off the NE corner of W. Jackson Rd. One mile west of Zeeb Rd. and One mile east of Baker Rd.

## Since 1921 over \$9,100,000.

**In FY2021, Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation distributed over \$643,237.**

- \$132,118 to support Local Children and Family Agencies and Services through our annual Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation Grant and Budget Process. (See list other side.)
- \$79,000 in Kiwanis "Finish Line" Scholarships to Washtenaw Community College students.
- \$49,695 in Kiwanis Vouchers for Free Household Goods to 134 Families.
- \$274,974 in direct gifts of Free Furniture and Merchandise to Local Nonprofit Organizations.
- \$84,540 Warm the Children as its Official Sponsor, giving 885 children new winter clothing.
- \$17,330 Salvation Army Annual Bell Ringing campaign in December 2020.
- \$5,580 in International Grants to Haiti Nursing Foundation Training Program

**Other Services and Gifts from Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Members, in addition to our Kiwanis Thrift Sale, include:**

  - Meals on Wheels: over 3,544 meals delivered last year.

- \$106,160 provided by members over the last 11 years to the Haiti Nursing Foundation.
- \$104,905 provided by members over 5 years in a shared effort with UNICEF and our Kiwanis International to Eliminate Maternal Neonatal Tetanus (MNT) across the world.
- \$104,268 provided by members in the 1990's for the Kiwanis and UNICEF campaign to end Iodine Deficiency Disorders (IDD) across the world.
