Who is the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor?

- We are Members, Volunteers, and Staff who help children, youth, families, & our community.
- October 2022, the Kiwanis Club and Foundation of Ann Arbor had 132 members, 116 volunteers, and 7 full-time and 6 part-time staff. In FY2022 we provided over 40,332 volunteer hours. Our Club was chartered in 1921 and our Foundation in 1965. Our Thrift Sale opened in 1927.

In FY2022, Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor Foundation distributed over \$1,084.424.

\$124,125 in additional grants as part of our Club's centennial shared between 3 agencies.

\$339,083 in direct gifts of Free Furniture and Merchandise to Local Nonprofit Organizations.

\$28,274 Student Leadership Programs and one individual scholarship

\$103,988 Warm the Children as its Official Sponsor, giving 1,110 children new winter clothing.

\$5,622 Salvation Army Annual Bell Ringing campaign in December 2021.

\$6,200 in International Grants to Haiti Nursing Foundation
